Blessing of Easter Food Baskets

We will be offering the Blessing of Easter Food Baskets at the end of all the Easter Sunday Masses

(March 30 & 31). A table will be set up next to the Blessed Mother where you can set your basket, and then after Mass take your basket home. This is a popular blessing in Eastern Europe. The Easter baskets are filled with food that will be consumed at the family Easter Sunday Meal. Traditional Easter foods that are put in these baskets are rich in scriptural significance.: Eggs are emblems of Jesus' tomb, which has been shattered to bring forth new life. Easter breads that are especially festive and yeastraised, they are a sign of being life-giving, with Jesus calling himself the bread of life. It is fitting to do this because the first meal of Easter breaks the 'paschal fast' of Good Friday and Holy Saturday. By fasting on Good Friday and Holy Saturday, we call to mind the holy cross of Jesus, which is the tree of new life, a tree planted among us on Good Friday. Adam and Eve ate from a tree and sinned. They broke the only rule that they were to follow, which was "to fast" from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. By fasting we show God that we are eager to come home to paradise.

Did you know your child can attend a Catholic School? Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2024-2025 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.
