Commemorative Ornament

You will have the chance to purchase a one-of-a-kind 24K etched brass commemorative ornament depicting a detailed image of our beautiful St. Anne’s Church. The cost of the ornament will be \$18. Buy one for yourself and one for each member of your family as a lifetime reminder of the memorable events that have happened here at St. Anne’s.

Commemorative Mugs and Tumblers

You will also want to check out the commemorative St. Anne ceramic mugs to hold your favorite morning blend and insulated tumblers to hold your hydration beverage of choice. Show your St. Anne pride with purchases of mugs priced at \$10 and tumblers priced at \$15.

Commemorative Shirts

Wear your St. Anne pride with Shirts, Shirts, Shirts! In this category you can find something for everyone. Styles will include T-shirts starting at \$12, Polo shirts starting at \$22, Women’s V-Neck shirts starting at \$22, and Hooded sweatshirts starting at \$30. Unlike the ornaments, mugs, and tumblers, order forms for selecting shirt style, color, and size will be provided to submit with payment. Individual shirt orders will be grouped into batches and delivered within a few weeks after the combined orders are placed.

All of these special St. Anne Centennial commemorative items are on schedule to be available for purchase/order at the St. Anne Spaghetti Supper on Saturday, October 20th and in the church vestibule after masses thereafter.
